TENTATIVE ITINERARY

DAY 01 | DEPARTURE DELHI – ARRIVE HELSINKI – Orientation Tour

Today you are to proceed to Delhi Indira Gandhi International Airport 04hours prior to departure and after clearing immigration and security check proceed to board your Delhi Helsinki flight scheduled to depart at 0750am.

On arriving Helsinki at 1410hrs clear immigration and proceed for a guided city tour After breakfast checkout and then proceed for a Guided orientation tour of Helsinki covering the Senate Square, Helsinki Cathedral, the Government Palace, the main building of the University of Helsinki and the National Library of Finland. A statue of Alexander II (1894) stands in the middle of the Senate Square. Helsinki Cathedral is arguably Finland's most famous and photographed building. Also visit the Sibelius Monument and the Rock Church in Helsinki.

Then visit the Kauppatori Square which means market square – Helsinki Harbour Market

Later proceed to a Indian restaurant for dinner and then to the hotel for check

Meals – Meals on Board, Dinner

DAY 02 | – Guided city Tour of PORVOO WITH LOCAL LUNCH – OVERNIGHT TRAIN TO KEMI

After breakfast, checkout and board coach to start the day's tour to Porvoo. Enjoy a guided tour of Porvoo- a deep dive into its medieval Old Town with cobblestone streets, iconic red riverside warehouses, and colorful wooden houses. The tour would cover landmarks like the Porvoo Cathedral and historic buildings and walking is the best way to explore the compact Old Town.

Visit the Red Wooden ware house , an iconic historic buildings lining the Porvoonjoki river in the picturesque Old Town (Vanha Porvoo). The charming, red-ochre structures, dating back to the 18th century, served as storage for goods and is a beloved national symbol, reflecting Finland's wooden architecture and history, often seen in photos with cobbled streets and colorful houses.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant in Porvoo serving traditional Finnish and Scandinavian delicacies.

In afternoon proceed towards Helsinki and have early dinner in restaurant and then proceed to the station to board the Santa Clause train to Kemi.

Overnight on-board Santa Clause Train

Meals – Breakfast, Local Lunch & Indian Dinner

DAY 03 | ARRIVE KEMI – Visit the SNOW CASTLE (entry) and RANUA ZOO (entry)

Breakfast on board train. Arrive Kemi -board coach and proceed to visit the Snow Castle. The Snow Castle of Kemi is the biggest snow fort in the world. It is rebuilt every winter with a different architecture in Kemi, Finland.

Later proceed towards Ranua Zoo where Arctic animals live. The only polar bear in Finland lives in this wildlife park, and it also has wolves, lynxes, wolverines, brown bears, arctic fox, owls, moose, reindeer, otters and much more.

Late afternoon proceed towards Rovaniemi (Approx 80Kms). Dinner at restaurant and then to the hotel for check-in .

Meals – Local breakfast on Board train & Dinner

DAY 04 | ROVANIEMI – SANTA CLAUSE VILLAGE – Reindeer Sledge Ride 880M - KIRUNA – Visit ICE HOTEL (entry)

After a satisfying breakfast you are to commence your journey towards the Santa Clause Holiday Village (about 8 kms from Rovaniemi Centre). You can meet Santa Claus and cross the magical Arctic Circle every day of the year at Santa Claus's Workshop Village in Rovaniemi. Rovaniemi is the capital of Lapland and the official hometown of Santa Clause. Enjoy the Reindeer Sledge ride (included in itinerary)

Spend some time there and then proceed towards Kiruna (Approx 340kms). Kiruna is a town in the far north of Swedish Lapland, known for the huge LKAB iron ore mine.

On arrival visit the Ice Hotel and then to the hotel for check in and dinner. After having dinner, explore the area for Aurora Hunt.

Overnight in Kiruna

Meals –Breakfast & Local Dinner

DAY 05 | KIRUNA – Orientation Tour - Travel through Abisko National Park – NARVIK (Approx 180kms)

This morning after breakfast, check out and proceed for a city orientation tour. Visit Kiruna Pastorat (Kiruna Church), a church building in Kiruna, one of Sweden's largest wooden buildings. The church exterior is built in a Gothic Revival style, while the altar is in Art Nouveau. Also visit the Lkab's Iron Ore mine (from outside) and then proceed towards Narvik via the Abisko National Park.

Arrive Narvik , Local dinner & Overnight in Narvik. Explore the area for Aurora Hunt after dinner.

Meals –Breakfast & Local Dinner

DAY 06 | NARVIK -Orientation Tour – TROMSO (Approx 232kms)

After breakfast, check out and proceed for an Orientation Tour of Narvik that offers a blend of dramatic Arctic landscapes, WWII history, and Sami culture, typically focused on navigating the town's mountainous surroundings and the Ofotfjord.

Head further North to the Northern Norway's capital city, Tromsø a city with modern restaurants and shops, surrounded by unspoiled wilderness. The city has its own university and brewery, and is surrounded by hundreds of islands, dramatic mountains and deep fjords. Tromsø is named the gateway to the Arctic, and today an entrance to experiencing the beauty of the Northern Lights. The Northern Lights reveals itself mostly north of the Arctic circle, and Tromsø is located in the centre of the Aurora heartland. In fact, it has one of the world's highest densities of the Northern Lights!

On arrival in Tromsø, proceed to enjoy the Fjellheisen (**Optional Cable car ride**) The Fjellheisen cable car brings you from Solliveien in Tromsdalen up to Storsteinen, 421 meters above sea level, in just four minutes.

Later check-in at the hotel and enjoy dinner. Later head for Aurora Hunt – the elusive lights in the sky.

Overnight in Tromso

Meals –Breakfast & Dinner

DAY 07 | TROMSO - Orientation Tour – ALTA Approx 300-400kms)

Breakfast at hotel and checkout. Proceed for an Orientation tour of Tromso covering Arctic Cathedral, Tromso Cathedral, Library, Harbour ,etc. Then board coach and proceed towards Alta - a town in Alta Municipality in Finnmark county, Norway. The town is the administrative centre of the municipality and the major commercial centre in the western part of the county of Finnmark.

On arrival check in to hotel and have local dinner. Later proceed for Aurora hunt at night.

Overnight in Alta

Meals –Breakfast & Dinner

DAY 08 | ALTA – Day Tour to HAMMERFEST (Approx 140Kms)- ALTA

After breakfast board coach and proceed towards Hammerfest- Hammerfest is famous as the world's northernmost city, known for its Arctic location, rich history as a polar hunting/fishing hub, unique attractions like the Royal and Ancient Polar Bear Society, the Struve Geodetic Arc (UNESCO site). On arrival do an orientation tour of Hammerfest and

then proceed to visit the The Royal and Ancient Polar Bear Society.

Later proceed back to Alta . Local dinner and then proceed for aurora hunt.

Overnight in Alta

Meals –Breakfast & Dinner

DAY 09 | ALTA – Entry to Rock Carvings at Alta – Ivalo -SAARISELKA / LEVI(APPROX 383Kms)

Early breakfast at hotel and checkout. Proceed to visit the Rock Carvings at Alta and then towards Saariselka via Ivalo and on the way photo stopping at Lake Inari, Finland's third-largest lake.

Arrive Saariselka / Levi and enjoy your stay in igloo . Enjoy the inhouse dinner and experience the night under the stars and if one is lucky could experience Aurora from your igloo.

Overnight in Saariselka/Levi

Meals –Breakfast & Dinner

DAY 10 | SAARISELKA – ROVANEIMI – HELSINKI

After breakfast checkout and proceed to Rovaniemi airport for your flight to Helsinki . Arrive Helsinki , collect baggage and board coach and proceed to the restaurant for dinner and then to the hotel for check-in .

DAY 11 | HELSINKI – REYKJAVIK - HELLA / HVOLSVÖLLUR(Approx 300kms)

After an early breakfast transfer to the Airport for your flight to Keflavik Airport. The Flight departs at 07:10 hrs and arrives in Keflavik at 09:20 Hrs. On arrival in Reykjavik, after immigration and customs formalities head out for the famous Golden Circle which is the nickname of one of the most captivating tour itineraries in all of Iceland. Home to volcanic landforms, surprising history, and some of the country's most picturesque locations, the route makes for a truly unmissable journey.

That's great, because , located in south-west Iceland, the Golden Circle is only a stone's throw from the charming Icelandic capital, Reykjavik. That means you can easily cover the area's three major sights in a day's journey from the city:Gullfoss Waterfall, Geysir Geothermal Park, Pingvellir National Park.

Strokkur, is there to keep you entertained. Strokkur erupts every 5 to 10 minutes and can shoot water as high as 40 metres. It's an awesome, euphoric thing to witness, not least because it's one of the few active geysers you can see in the world.

Not far from Geysir is one of Iceland's best-known waterfalls: Gullfoss. It's one of the largest

waterfalls in Europe by volume—and it's certainly one of the most beautiful.

The third major site in the Golden Circle is Þingvellir National Park, a place of momentous natural and historical importance for Iceland and the world. It was Iceland's first national park and it remains a UNESCO World Heritage Site for good reason—so you'll have lots to explore.

In the evening check-in at a Hotel in Hvalsöllum. Local 3 Course Dinner. Later explore the area in search of the magic of Aurora Borealis.

Meals – Breakfast, Local Dinner

DAY 12 | HELLA / HVOLSVÖLLUR – Jökulsárlón – Reynisfjara

After breakfast, the day's tour would be amidst natural landscapes as you drive to the Southern Shores of Iceland to Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon & Diamond Beach.

Jökulsárlón is a large glacial lake in Iceland that developed after the glacier started receding in the late 19th century. It is one of the most attractive natural wonders of the world. People are blown away by the stunning vastness and unique beauty as majestic icebergs make their way through the enormous lagoon to the Atlantic Ocean. With its enormous and ancient icebergs breaking off from Vatnajökull glacier, this natural wonder of Iceland is a sight to behold. The lagoon produces a feeling of incredible tranquility as the 1000 – 1500 years old ice silently drifts into the lake and slowly melts away. The lagoon covers 18 square kilometres and reaches more than 248 metres at its deepest point. You may recognize the lagoon from scenes in Batman Begins, Tomb Raider and two James Bond movies.

You can stop at the gorgeous Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss waterfalls!!! Seljalandsfoss is part of the Seljandsá river, which has its origins in Eyjafjallajökull glacier and what makes it so famous and interesting is that you can walk behind it. We recommend you to bring either a raincoat or a waterproof coat along if you wish to walk behind it. Skógafoss, another famous Icelandic waterfall, is the starting point of the Fimmvörðuháls walk over to Þórsmörk. This waterfall was also used in the movies like Thor: The Dark World and The Secret Life of Walter Mitty.

Also stop at Vík í Mýrdal and walk to Reynisfjara, a world-famous black sand beach located in southern Iceland, to see the Reynisdrangar rock formations. It is known for its dramatic basalt columns, unique rock formations, and powerful waves. The beach is a popular tourist destination and has been featured in various movies and TV shows, including "Game of Thrones".

Finally, return back for dinner and then head to the hotel for rest. Later, proceed outdoors in search for the elusive lights in the sky.

DAY 13 | HELLA / HVOLSVÖLLUR – KIRKJUFELL-REYKJAVÍK (450kms)

After breakfast drive through scenic landscape to the western part of Iceland to Kirkjufell,

standing tall above the small fishing town of Grundarfjörður, Kirkjufell is the most photographed mountain in Iceland, one of the top 10 most beautiful mountains in the world, and yet most recognized as being “Arrow Head Mountain” on Game of Thrones.

Later drive to Reykjavík

Reykjavík, capital and largest city of Iceland. It is located on the Seltjarnar Peninsula, at the southeastern corner of Faxa Bay, in southwestern Iceland.

According to tradition, Reykjavík (“Bay of Smokes”) was founded in 874 by the Norseman Ingólfur Arnarson. Until the 20th century it was a small fishing village and trading post. It was granted municipal powers and was designated the administrative centre of the Danish-ruled island on Aug. 18, 1786. The seat of the Althingi (parliament) since 1843, it became the capital of a self-governing Iceland under the Danish king in 1918 and of the independent Republic of Iceland in 1944.

On arrival in Reykjavik, proceed for a guided city tour. Local 3 Course Dinner. Check-in at the Hotel. Overnight in Reykjavik.

DAY 14 | REYKJAVIK – HELSINKI – DELHI- Departure

After an early breakfast checkout and proceed to Keflavik airport for your return flight back home to Delhi via Helsinki. Arrive Helsinki and board your connecting flight to Delhi

DAY 15 | ARRIVE – DELHI

Finally arrive Indira Gandhi International Airport in the morning at around 0605 hours where you will separate from the group and head home with happy memories.
